Note:

- 1) The minimum eligibility for the post of JPF is 55% marks at the post graduation.
- 2) It is the responsibility of the candidates to ensure that they fulfill the eligibility conditions in terms of (i) educational qualifications
(ii) experience etc.
- 3) Fellowship is purely temporary.
- 4) Candidates already in job should forward their applications through their employer and/or come with a "No Objection Certificate", without which the candidate will not be allowed for appearing in interview.
- 5) *The Project Fellows who have already worked in the Council for two years need not apply.***
- 6) Candidate should bring their original certificates at the time of interview.
- 7) No TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview
- 8) The selected candidates may be required to join immediately.
- 9) Candidates should bring along their written or published work (if any).
